Timemaster Big Date

The Timemaster family has always played a big role within Chronoswiss's collection. This sports line inspired by rich traditional elements including a strikingly large onion-style crown has been enriched with the numerous new models over the last few years. Only a model that includes a large date was missing up to now, much to the chagrin of connoisseurs of the brand. Now it's time for a change: at Baselworld 2011 Chronoswiss introduced the Timemaster Big Date. This long-awaited new model offers more than "just" the big date, though: a power reserve indication is also prominently placed at 12 o'clock. This way, the Timemaster Big Date's wearer always knows when it's time to get out and move – an incredibly sensible additional function even on automatic watches.

The new Timemaster offers a lot not only in a functional sense but also in a visual sense: it is very obviously part of the powerful Timemaster family with its sporty design combined with fresh, colorful accents. Its outer appearance and striking measurements promise its wearer a robust companion – every hour of the day: the intensely luminous elements coated with SuperLumi-Nova on the dial, hands, and even the bezel make the Timemaster Big Date extremely legible, even at night. Whether the case you choose is stainless steel or steel coated with ultra-hard DLC to make the case an attractive anthracite color, this sports watch is a big deal.
